COMPETITION RULES

Members will be accepted into competitions provided they have submitted their entry form and total entrance fee to the Competition Secretary by the due date indicated on the entry form. Forms submitted without the fees will not be accepted into the draw.

When the draw is made for pairs or triples competitions there may be an excess of competitors. These competitors will be the only valid reserves, and will be selected by ballot. Should a valid reserve not be available, a team requiring a reserve during the competition will forfeit their game.

The first named player (**THE CHALLENGER**) shall offer **THREE** dates to the opponent at least 10 days before close of round, one of which must be a weekend. The opponent must accept one of the offered dates within 48 hours, and this will be the appointed date. If a date cannot be agreed the Challenger is entitled to claim the game. If the Challenger has not offered **THREE** dates to the opponent by the start of the 10-day period then the opponent can claim the game. A game is claimed by entering your name into the next round.

If any games are not completed or claimed as described in **RULE 3** by the expiry date of the round, both competitors will be eliminated 24 hours after the said expiry date. The contestant awaiting the result of any such game will progress through to the next round.

All **FINALS** must be played on Finals Weekend, and players must be available to play their games on either day without exception.

Finals Weekend is 1st/2nd September 2012.

Any disagreement in respect of fulfilling matches or of interpretation of the rules is to be referred to the Competition Secretary whose decision will be final.

Expiry dates for each round will be published on the draw sheets displayed in the pavilion.

PARKING Best on Quarry Road but beware of “Resident Only” parking bays.

DIRECTIONS

Travelling from South and East.

M4 junction 15

North on A419 exiting just before flyover at Great Western hospital junction.

Take first exit at roundabout towards Swindon.

At next roundabout keep left and take first exit (Not Coate Water) and follow Marlborough Road towards Old Town.

Keep on Marlborough Road across two mini-roundabouts.

At next major roundabout take third exit towards Old Town.

Follow road up the hill to roundabout and turn left into Newport Street.

Turn left at mini roundabout at top of Newport Street.

First right into Springfield Road leading to Westlecot Road.

First right is Quarry Road.

Travelling from North.

Keep on A419 towards M4 Junction 15 and exit before flyover at Great Western Hospital.

Take fourth exit towards Swindon then follow directions above.

Travelling from South and West.

M4 junction 16.

Head towards Swindon on Great Western Way.

Take second exit on first roundabout still on Great Western Way.

At next roundabout with traffic lights keep right and take third exit onto Wootton Bassett Road towards Town Centre/Old Town.

Follow road until roundabout at bottom of Kingshill. Take second exit to Old Town.

Take second exit on next mini-roundabout up Kingshill.

At roundabout at top of the hill straight on onto Bath Road.

Quarry Road is the second turning on the right.
